Summer EBT

- Permanent program providing grocery benefits to eligible households with schoolaged children to support food access during summer break.
- Increases summer food options for students that receive free and reduced price school meals but may struggle to access traditional summer meals programs.



Summer Electronic Benefits Transfer for Children




- Beginning in 2011, SEBTC piloted the use of electronic benefits transfer in providing food assistance to children with low-incomes during the summer.
- Tested SNAP and WIC models at \$30 and \$60 benefit levels through select states and Tribal Organizations.



- Impact:
 - Reduced very-low food insecurity by a third.
 - Increased children's consumption of whole grains, fruits, vegetables, and dairy.



Pandemic EBT





- Temporary program that provided grocery benefits to families with children qualified for free or reduced price school meals when schools were closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Guidelines, eligibility, and benefit levels changed and evolved, as the pandemic did, to adapt to hybrid situations and changing legislation.

S-EBT Policy: Administration

Dec 29, 2022 Jun 7, 2023 Dec 29, 2023 Jan 1, 2024 Feb 15, 2024 S-EBT passed First S-EBT Interim Final Intent to Plan Rule (IFR) as option for all guidance implement submissions published from FNS states in '24 due due

- Creation of permanent, nationwide program option
- SNAP/NAP option for states & territories, WIC option for ITOs
- 50% admin funding
- Must be a partnership between CN & SNAP, and between ITOs & states
- Ongoing timelines for interim and final plans each year



S-EBT Policy: Eligibility

- Students can be eligible to receive S-EBT benefits if:
 - They can be streamline certified (receive benefits automatically) by being
 - school aged* and directly certified by SNAP, TANF, FDPIR, or Medicaid (in direct cert pilot states)
 - individually certified for free/reduced price meals
 - They complete an application to become individually certified
- Students in special provision schools must complete an application if they cannot otherwise be directly certified
 - By 2025, agencies must have state-wide application
 - 3% of applications must be verified, and any application can be verified for cause



^{*} School aged is currently defined state-by-state using compulsory age for school attendance

S-EBT Policy: Benefits

- \$40/month or \$120 for the summer period in 2024
 - Indexed to inflation
 - WIC benefit should be equivalent in value
- Delivered on EBT card or other methods as approved by FNS
 - Can be on an existing or new EBT card
- Benefits intended to be used in summer
 - 4 month/122 day expungement period
