

Getting Started

- Choose a few ideas that are a good fit for your school or district.
- Adapt the ideas to best meet your needs and goals.
- Take it down a notch or up a notch.
- Start with something and take on more from there.





Challenges

- Great way to build excitement around school breakfast.
- Good for short-term participation boosts; best paired with other strategies for sustained participation increases.

Lucky Tray Day

• Place a sticker or a special mark under a select number of breakfast trays. Students who receive a "lucky tray" win a prize.

Golden Ticket Day

 Place a "golden ticket" in select grab & go breakfast bags. Students who receive a "golden ticket" win a prize.

Breakfast Club Cards

• Students receive a breakfast club card and collect a sticker or stamp each day they eat breakfast. When the card is complete, students win a prize or the completed card serves as a raffle entry to win a prize.

- Contests
 - Great for building excitement and generating awareness.
- Contest Types
 - Art/Poster
 - Video
 - Essay



- Special Guests or Guest Servers
 - Best for engaging students and parents/families.
 - Think about the "celebrities" in your school community.
 - Who would students be excited to see help serve breakfast or join them at their breakfast table?
 - Ask school administrators, first responders, athletes, or veterans to be special guests.



Social Media


- Best for engaging students, parents/families, teachers, and administrators.
- If your school or district has active social media accounts, embrace these channels to promote breakfast.
- Post photos, announce the menu, introduce new items, promote special events, shout out your staff, etc.








- Posters, Flyers, Newsletters


