

What is the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)?

Enables eligible schools to provide breakfast and lunch to all students at no cost to them

- Reduced stigma for eating school meals
- Improved behavior and academic outcomes
- Reduced financial stress for parents
- Eliminate unpaid school meal debt!
- Simplified counting and claiming
- Improved school nutrition staff morale
- Facilitates meals in the classroom

Schools, or groups of schools, must have an "Identified Student Percentage" (ISP) of 40% to operate CEP

CEP is a 4-year cycle.




USDA extended free meals for all this school year...

So why should I apply for CEP?


- Applying for CEP now is a no-risk opportunity to lock in your current ISPs, high reimbursement rates, and ability to serve free school meals to all through SY 24-25.
- If your ISPs continue to increase next year, then you can lock in higher rates next year.
- If you don't apply for CEP this year, and your ISPs decrease next year, then it will have been a missed opportunity to lock in the current peak reimbursement rates.
- USDA extended the CEP application deadline to September 30.*
- If you have the capacity to run your numbers and apply by the end of September, we recommend doing so. If your capacity is limited, please reach out – we are happy to help!
