

Purpose of Cohort

- Part of a pilot effort to test emerging strategies that leverage the potential of health care settings and systems to expand access to food and to nutrition programs for families.
- Goal: To provide tested clinical-community food access interventions that are locally sustainable and that can be leveraged in other rural areas to address the food needs of families before hunger becomes a crisis.







Clinical Referral Dr. Mary Williams, a nurse practitioner whose patient base is approximately half Medicaid recipients, will identify participants to receive monthly produce prescriptions for the local formers market or formstands and to participate in cooking

Delivery Model

 Clinical partners screen adult patients for food insecurity
Those who are experiencing food insecurity and have a child living in their home will be referred to FAST Blackfeet, with any health conditions for Medical Nutrition Therapy noted
FAST Blackfeet will offer MNT or culturally relevant nutrition education and therapeutics foods from the Ö yö •p Food Pantry
Fresh produce vouchers are also offered at food retailers across Blackfeet Nation
