# Waivers for School Year 2021-22

- Allow all schools to operate SSO
- Allow SFSP reimbursement rates for SSO
- Non-congregate meal service
- Meal service time flexibility
- Parent/guardian pick-up
- CEP deadlines extended to Sept. 30

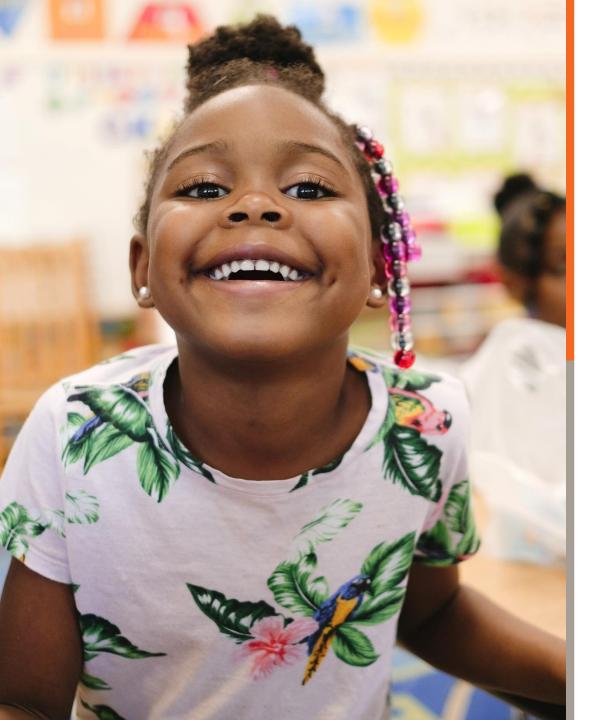

## What is the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)?

- Enables eligible schools to provide breakfast and lunch to all students at no cost to them
  - Students have equitable access to all meals – reduced stigma
  - School nutrition fund *can* benefit tremendously
  - Decreased administrative burden
- CEP is a 4-year cycle
- Schools, or groups of schools, must have an "Identified Student Percentage" (ISP) of 40% to operate CEP

### **Benefits of CEP**

- Healthy school meals for all students!
- Improved student behavioral and academic outcomes
- Reduced stigma for participating in school meals
- Eliminate unpaid school meal debt
- Decreased financial stress for parents
- Improved school nutrition staff morale
- Simplified counting and claiming only need to count the total number of meals served
- Facilitates Breakfast After the Bell (BAB)
- Reduced administrative burden

# of "identified" students

x 100

### Identified Student Percentage (ISP)

Identified students are categorically-eligible and directly certified for free school meals.

Students should be included in the ISP if they live in a household that participates in...

- SNAP: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- TANF: Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
- FDP / FDPIR: Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations
- Medicaid: Medicaid Free only; Medicaid Reduced cannot be included in the ISP

Students should also be included in the ISP if they are...

- in foster care,
- experiencing homelessness,
- in Head Start/Early Head Start, and/or
- Migrants

...however, their eligibility does *not* extend to siblings or other household members.

### **CEP Reimbursement Pattern**

Two categories of reimbursement: Free & Paid

Free reimbursement rate =  $ISP \times 1.6$ 

**Paid reimbursement rate** = 100% – (ISP x 1.6)

"Magic ISP" = 62.5% (62.5% x 1.6 = 100% of meals reimbursed at the federal free rate)

ISP	x 1.6 Multiplier	% of Meals Reimbursed at "Free" rate	% of Meals Reimbursed at "Paid" Rate
40%	x1.6	64%	36%
45%	x1.6	72%	28%
50%	x1.6	80%	20%
55%	x1.6	88%	12%
60%	x1.6	96%	4%
65%	x1.6	100%	0%



### Grouping

- The 40% threshold may be met by:
  - an individual school,
  - a group of schools within the district, or
  - all schools in the district.
- Groupings can maximize reimbursement and participation by students.
- Consider grouping high ISP, high enrollment schools with lower ISP, lower enrollment schools

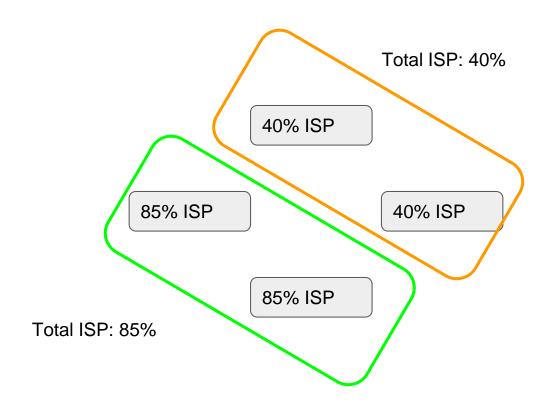

Meals Count is driven by an <u>open source software</u> application that **automatically calculates optimal school groupings** for the purposes of CEP, eliminating the need for time-consuming, often-overwhelming manual calculations.



- Takes in data from school districts per school
  - Total Enrolled
  - Total Eligible
  - Average Daily Breakfast Served
  - Average Daily Lunch Served
- Uses computers to run many different grouping scenarios
- Recommends grouping with the highest potential reimbursement
- Allows adjusting which schools to run the algorithms on





- **Recommended Grouping:** The numerical grouping of the schools in the current recommendation. E.g. All Schools marked "1" should be in Group 1, all schools marked "2" should be in Group 2
- School Code: The code or id of the school (must be unique for each school)
- School Name: The name of the school (for reference)
- Total Enrolled: The total number of students enrolled in this school
- Total Eligible: The total number of Identified Students in this school
- Breakfast Avg Daily Participation: The average DAILY number of breakfasts served
- Lunch Avg Daily Participation: The average DAILY number of lunches served
- Severe Need: Whether or not this school qualifies as Severe Need
- **Included in Optimization**: Whether or not to include this school in the optimization (e.g. exclude charter schools)
- Estimated School ISP: ISP as percentage calculated live from Total Eligible/ Total Enrolled
- School CEP Eligible: Whether or not the School meets the 40% threshold
- Estimated Annual Reimbursement: The estimated reimbursement based upon the Rates specified and a 180 day school year for this school

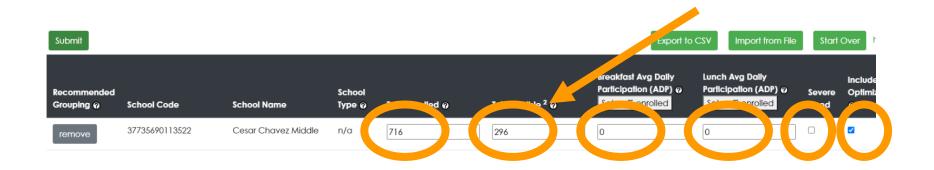

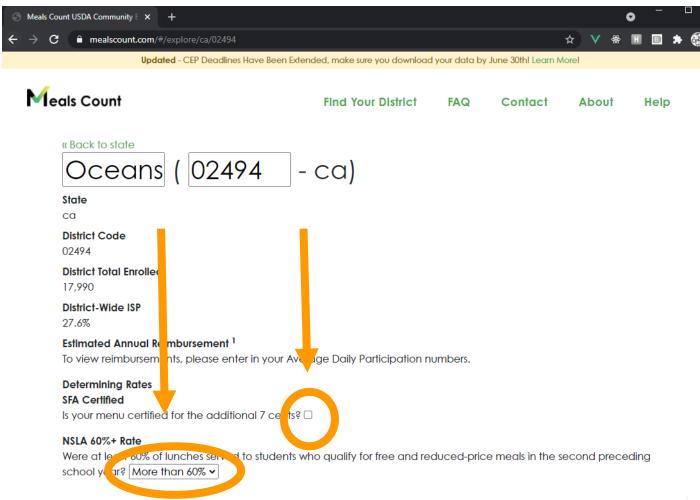

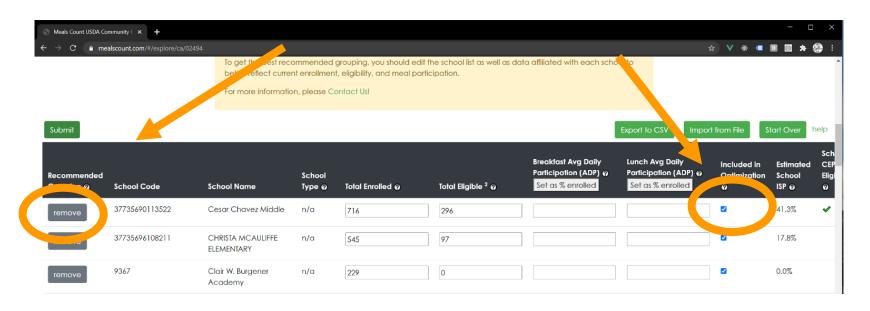

Remove or uncheck "Included" for any unapplicable schools

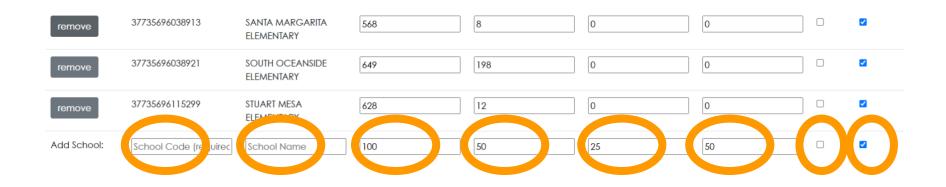


Some schools (e.g. Charter Schools, or sometimes school offices) are included from our source data set but may not be part of your district's meal program.

You can either "disable" this from the grouping calculation, or remove it entirely by toggling "Included in Optimization" to disable, or "remove" to remove.

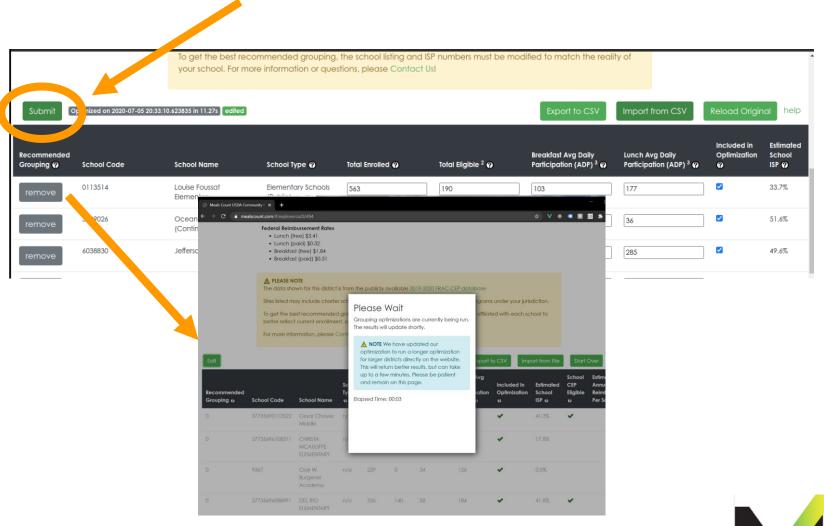


You must specify 8 fields to add a school

- 1. School Code (numerical code, can just be placeholder if you don't have one, **must be unique to district**)
- 2. School Name (name of school, must be unique to district)
- 3. Total Enrolled
- 4. Total Eligible
- 5. Breakfast Average Daily Participation
- 6. Lunch Average Daily Participation
- 7. Severe Need
- 8. Included in Optimization (keep checked to include in grouping calculation)



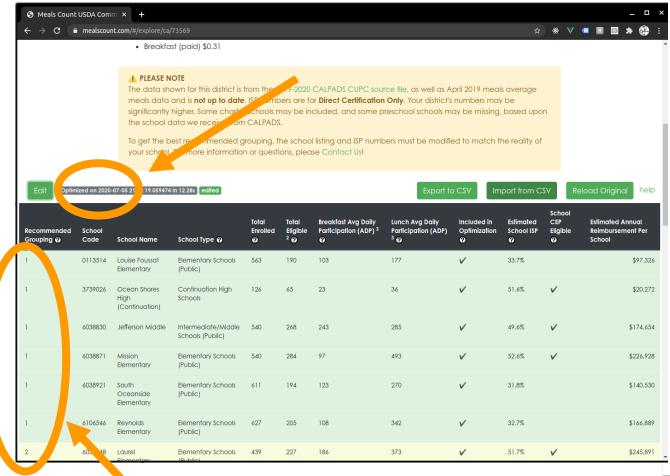

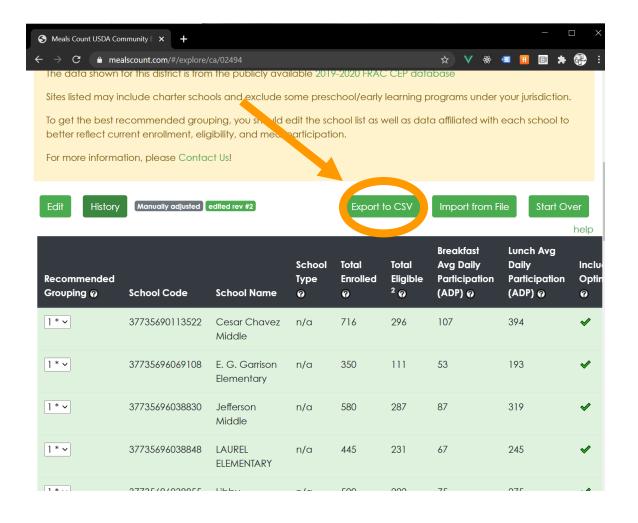

Look at the history of your optimized and adjusted groupings, and click to go back to one

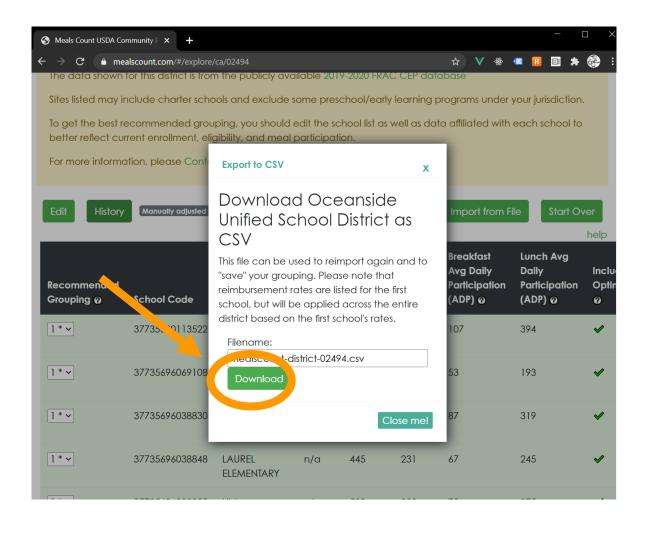

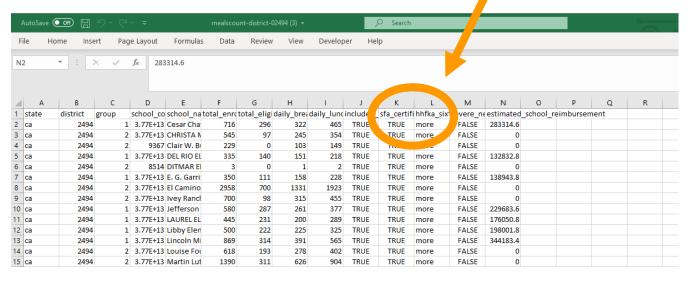

#### Review / Share the resulting file

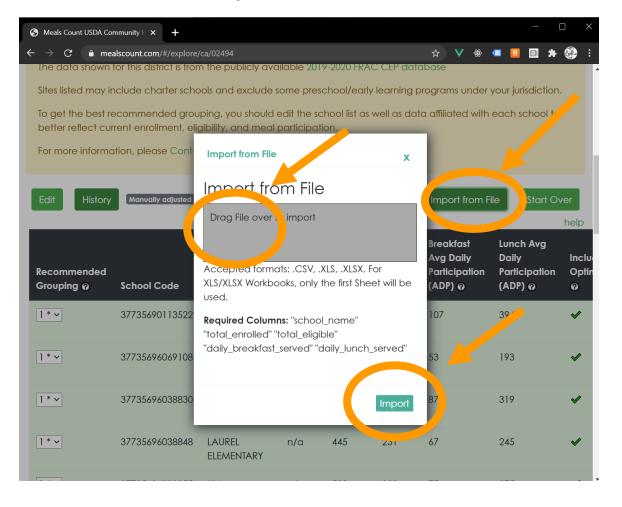
**NOTE:** CSV or Comma Separated Value files are compatible, but not the same as XLS or XLSX files. If you modify and save these files as XLS or XLSX, you will need to "Save As" a CSV to be able to re-import to Meals Count



**NOTE:** The sfa certification and 60% (hhfka\_sixty) fields are on every school row but are district wide values that are just taken from the first school on import.



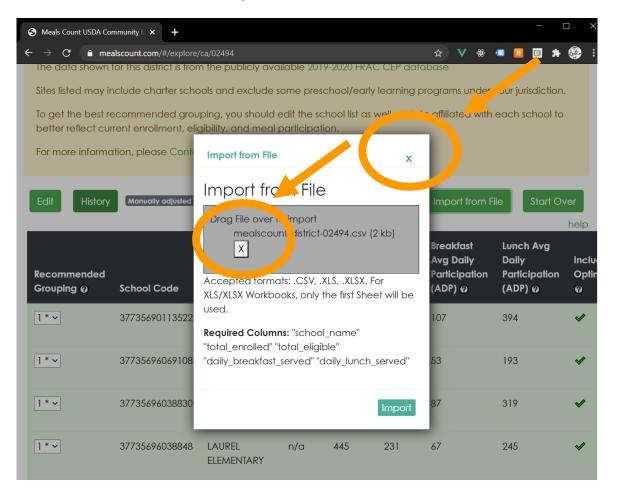
Click Import from File to import XLSX or CSV Data



Drag and Drop your CSV or XLS file onto the gray box, then click Import



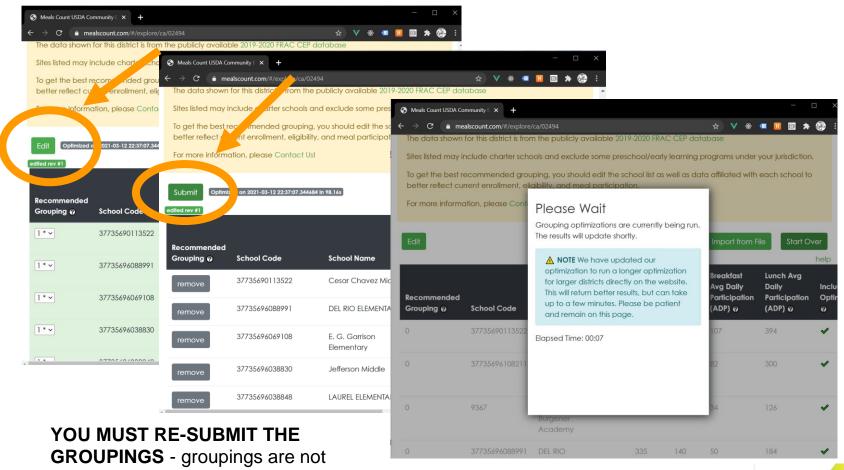
Click Import from File to import XLSX or CSV Data



Once you have clicked Import, then click Close at the top



Upon Importing, Click "Edit" and then "Submit" to recalculate groupings



GROUPINGS - groupings are not automatically imported from the Import CSV, and will remain what they were before import



Note on Saving / Sharing

- You must Export to CSV to "Save" your district
- To share a district, send the user the CSV File you exported
- You may create unlimited "CSV" exports as a way of testing different scenarios
- To load a "saved" district, Import from CSV and then click "Edit" and "Submit" to recalculate groupings and estimate reimbursements

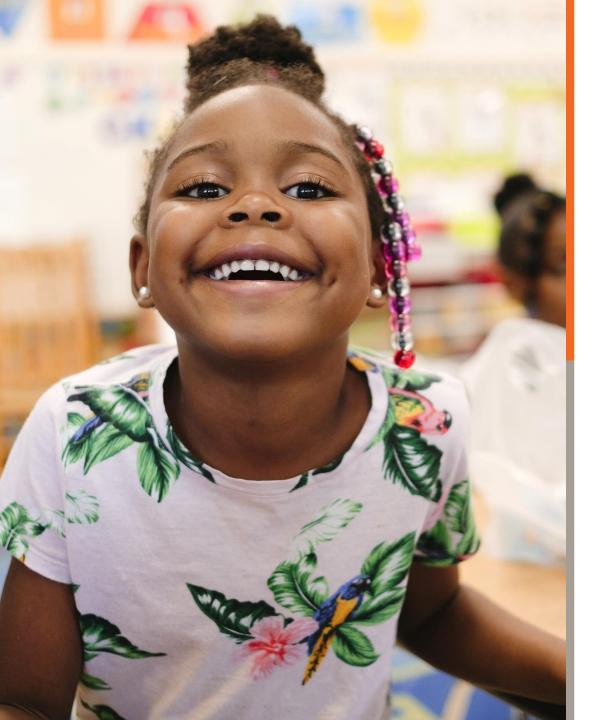

#### **Meals Count Considerations**

- Data listed is pulled from the 2020-2021 FRAC database
- All data listed is historical data. Districts MUST EDIT enrollment and ISP data, as well as add their ADP data to get accurate grouping suggestions.
- Multiple strategies for optimizing ISP
- Does not include state reimbursement
- Consider possible increase in participation
