


Rural America and Hunger Problems

- About 1 in 5 Americans live in rural areas
- 16.4% of Americans in rural areas live in poverty

Rural Poverty Rates by Race/Ethnicity Groups









Rural America and Hunger Solutions

- Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)
- Less success in rural areas
 - Lower concentrations of eligible children
 - Fewer available food sites
 - Longer travel requirements
 - Limited transportation options



Meals-to-You Summer 2019 TX








Meals-to-You Summer 2019 TX

Meals-to-You Summer 2020 TX, NM + AK








Meals-to-You Summer 2020 TX, NM + AK


