

NKH Standard Data Request

Regular collection of data is essential for understanding the baseline and ongoing progress in any NKH community. For federal child nutrition programs including breakfast, summer, and afterschool, all states must report school- and site-level meal data to USDA. USDA only publicly shares data at the state level, so it is important to forge relationships to gain access to more granular data. Share Our Strength recommends developing a partnership with the administering state agency or local school district. Below is the standard data request.

1. School Breakfast (SBP) and School Lunch (NSLP)

- Total Reduced NSLP Afterschool Snacks served
- Number of Operating Days of Service for each meal type
- School Breakfast Delivery Method (e.g. traditional cafeteria, breakfast in the classroom, grab and go, etc.)

2. Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and Seamless Summer Option (SSO)
